



- **Flexible Transport:** We travel in a comfortable van (for 4–6 guests) or a standard passenger car for groups of 3 or less. This is the only way to navigate narrow stone streets and reach the villages where the train doesn't stop.
- **Boutique Stays:** We skip generic chains for hand-picked local gems. You'll stay in charming accommodations that reflect the true character and "soul" of the Southwest.
- **A Taste of the Region:** To truly feel the local vibe, please note the traditional cuisine here is rich in meat and dairy cheese. It is a food lover's paradise for those who enjoy the authentic, hearty flavors of the French countryside.
- **Active Exploration:** We'll be roaming ancient, hilly villages and cobblestone streets. This trip is for those who enjoy being on their feet and soaking in the scenery.

Packing Like a Local – What to bring for a French spring in the Southwest

- **The Spring Bloom:** Temperatures range from 10°C to 20°C. Expect lush green vineyards, crisp mornings, and mild afternoons.
- **Comfort First:** Bring your most comfortable walking shoes or sturdy sneakers. We'll be navigating uneven cobblestones and hilly village paths (yes, with plenty of pauses!).
- **Be Rain-Ready:** Spring can be unpredictable. A waterproof jacket or sturdy umbrella is a must so we can keep exploring the markets, rain or shine.
- **The "Cave Chill":** Even on a sunny day, the underground river and wine cellars stay a constant 13°C. You'll definitely want a light layer or sweater for these visits.
- **No Pressure Style:** If you want to bring something a bit "nicer" for Bordeaux, go for it! But it's completely optional. The French dress exactly how they want—there is zero pressure to be anything but yourself.
- **Your Comfort Kit:** Since we value "me-time," bring the little things that make you feel at home. Whether it's a journal, a book, or a small painting kit, bring what helps you recharge. (If you paint, I can help you find local paper in France!)
